Natural Attraction Destinations



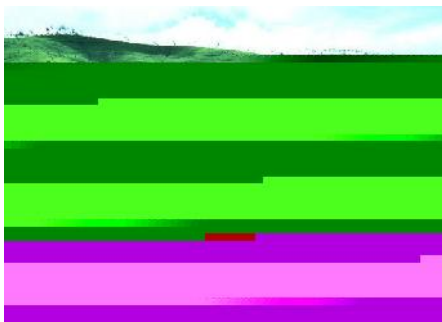
One of the most attractive places on Horton plains is the World's end. It is located about 32 Km from Nuwara Eliya. Eventhough the name World's End gives the meaning of there is only one, infact there are two of them called as "Small world's end " & "Big world's end". From here, one could get a fantastic view of the sorrounding mountain ranges, tea estates, rivers etc. On clear days, one can even sea the indian ocean which is about 100Km away to the south.



Horton Plains is also known as one of the most famous tourist destinations in Sri Lanka which is situated in Nuwara Eliya, Rathnapura & Badulla districts. This beautiful plateau which is situated at an altitude of 2100 - 2300 metres is very rich in biodiversity and many species found in this area are endemic to the region. This region was designated as a National part in the year of 1988. Many rivers in Sri Lanka starts from this location. Water here is very cold and pure.



Hakgala Botanical Garden, one the three botanical gardens in Sri Lanka. It is the second largest of all three gardens. It is situated on the Nuwara Eliya - Badulla main road about 16 km from Nuwara Eliya. Since this area is about 5,400 feet above sea level, the climate around here is cool where the anual temperature ranges between 16C to 30C. There are over 10,000 species of flora planted here which attracts thousands of visitors during the Spring season. The anual visitors is around 500,000. This garden is very famous for Orchids and Roses.



Sri Lankan hill country is very famous for its tea plantations. During the tours these plantation factories can be visited to see tea growing, how it is being proceessed, whatmechines are used in the process etc. (Why not have a cup of tea & relax a bit before leaving the factory?). You can even stay and relax as you wish in bungalows which are situated in these plantation areas.

Haputale is also a beautiful place surrounded by mountain ranges and mist which covers them. This location is a great place to have a bird's eye view of the whole Uva province and an amazing sight of the Horton Plains and the World's End. Tea factories are also located in Haputale so that passing by visitors can always have a visit.



Sinharaja Rain Forest is a World Heritage site which is also a biodiversity hot spot. This place is a major eco-tourist destination in Sri Lanka. Even though the reserve is only 21 km from east to west and 7 km from north to south, it is a treasure of endemic species including trees & animals which you cannot find anywhere else in this world. Bird watching in this forest is really interesting because it is the home for 95% of the endemic birds in Sri Lanka.



St. Clair's Waterfall is one of the widest waterfalls in Sri Lanka. It is also known as the Little Niagara Falls. It is situated 3 km west of the town of Thalawakele on the Hatton - Thalawakele Highway in Nuwara Eliya (one of the most coolest places in Sri Lanka). This beautiful waterfall got its name from the nearby tea estate. St. Clair's is about 80 m high and it is the 20th highest waterfall in Sri Lanka.

Locations of Ancient Heritage Values



"Sigiriya" which is also called as "Sinha Giriya" or "Lion's Rock" is a town which has a large stone and many ancient ruins which is once a fortress. On top of the rock the ruins of the palace can be found. Sigiriya is situated in the Matale District of the Central Province of Sri Lanka. Sigiriya is surrounded by an extensive network of gardens, water ponds, water gardens, reservoirs and many more structures. This entire complex was built by the king Kashyapa in 495 AD. Sigiriya is also famous for its paintings which are reminiscent of the Ajanta Caves of India. Sigiriya is one of the eight world heritage sites in Sri Lanka.

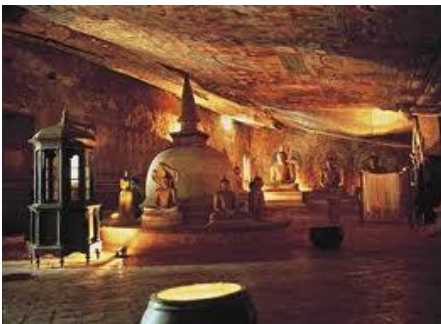
"Anuradhapura" is one of the major cities in Sri Lanka which is once the capital of this island. It is situated about 205Km North of the capital city Colombo. Anuradhapura is famous for its well-preserved ruins of ancient civilization which dates from the 4th century BC. This large ancient city includes several huge dagoba monuments which towers to the sky. Apart from that there many rock cave temples, bathing reservoirs and ancient bodhi tree which is believed to be the oldest tree in the entire world at over 2000 years. This tree is a part of the bodhi tree which was in india that is believed to be the tree which lord Buddha attained enlightenment. There are many more stone carved structures such as moon-stones etc in this area which attracts many local and foreign tourists.



"Polonnaruwa" was the second most major city in Sri Lankan ancient civilization. It is an ancient capital city which dates from 11-13th centuries. This city contains many number of massive stone-carved buddha statues, stupa's, temples and many more ruins such as the royal palace of the king, Stone books where ancient people have written things on a flat stone etc. You can also visit the museum to find out how grand this city was those days. Apart from ruins, there are many large reservoirs which facinates all the people.



"Yapahuwa" served as the capital city of Sri Lanka in late 13th century. It is built on a large 90 meter high granite rock in the style of Sigiriya rock fortress. In ancient days, Yapahuwa was a palace and a military stronghold against invaders. Visitors can still vitness the ancient battle defences and the ornamental stairway which is the most attractive structure. There are several caves around the rock which contains ancient images of lord Buddha.



"Dambulla" is famous for its largest and well preserved cave temple complex in Sri Lanka. According to the records there are around 80 caves in the sorrounding area while most of the attractions spread towards 5 of them which contains ancient statues and paintings which relates to the lord Buddha's life. There are around 153 Buddha statues, 3 statues of ancient Sri Lankan kings and 4 statues of god and goddess. Apart from that another main attraction of this area is the Rangiri Dambulu International Stadium.

Sandy beaches



"Bentota Beach" is the prime beach resort of the western coast belt in Sri Lanka where many tourists love to visit & have a wonderful vacation. It is also close to the Kalutara & Beruwala bay beach which is also famous for broad golden sandy beaches of Sri Lanka. bentota is located about 64Km south of Colombo. In here you can find accommodation ranging from 5 star to midrange according to your budget. During the season (November - April) this beach is ideal from wind surfing, diving, sailing and for many more water sports.



"Negombo Beach" also offers a wide stretch of quiet beaches on the western coast of Sri Lanka. Negombo is also famous for fishing. There are fish auctions daily where tourists get a chance to organise some fishing trips to the lagoon. Negombo is also popular among visitors because of water sports and few well preserved coral reefs and a shipwreck which serves as a artificial coral reef for many types of fish in the near by area. Negombo also has local handicraft, jewellery shops as well.



"Hikkaduwa Beach" is a well known beach resort in Sri Lanka which is very famous for its beach, wind surfing, diving, corals and night life. The only marine sanctuary of Sri Lanka is situated in Hikkaduwa which is the home to around 70 types of corals. Hikkaduwa is also famous for the annual festival where many local and foreign tourists love to visit and have a good time that will never forget in your life.



"Nilaveli Beach" is considered as one of the most beautiful purest white sand beaches in Asia. Close to Nilaveli you can visit Pigeon island which is a marine national park. It contains some of the best remaining coral reefs of Sri Lanka. Nilaveli is located about 275Km from Colombo, on the North East coast of Sri Lanka. This beach is also famous for visiting the Pigeon island, snorkeling in near by corals and dolphin watching.
